

~ 2010 Compost Bin, Rain Barrel & Kitchen Pail Sale ~



Fundraising Details

Norseman Plastics, the company supplying the Compost Bins (Earth Machine™), System™ Rain Barrels and the Kitchen Pails, has agreed to allow communities or organizations to sell the compost bin for \$42 (the total cost of the bin) or for \$47 (a \$5 fund raising opportunity for each bin sold), rain barrels for \$60 or \$65 (\$5.00 fund raising opportunity for each rain barrel sold) and to sell the Kitchen Pails at \$8.00 or \$10 (a \$2.00 fund raising opportunity for each pail sold).

The one important difference between selling these items as a Fundraiser vs a Straight Sale is that communities or organizations who sell items as a Fundraiser **must write one check** to the Northeast Resource Recovery Association (NRRA) for the total amount due, for ALL items ordered (rather than having individual checks made out to the NRRA).

For Example:

Using this as a fundraiser, the Recycletown Boy Scouts sell 100 bins at \$47 each, and collect \$4,700 in cash or checks (made out to "Recycletown Boy Scouts"). The Boy Scouts then submit one check made out to the NRRA for \$4,200 and send it with the Final Order Form to the NRRA. Consequently, the 2010 Composting Sale, results in raising \$500 for the Recycletown Boy Scouts!
