



# ELECTRONICS RECYCLING



## *A NRRA Cooperative Recycling Program*

Northeast Resource Recovery Association (NRRA) has developed 5 Electronics Recycling programs: the **ePOD Program**, the **Gaylord Program**, **One Day Collection Events**, **Containerized Programs** and the **On-Site Trailer Program**.

### **ePOD Program**



Members collect and store electronics in an enclosed ePOD provided by NRRA's vendor. Electronics may be stacked to the ceiling of the ePOD. When full, members simply contact NRRA to arrange for an ePOD swap.

### **Gaylord Electronics Recycling Program**



Members collect and store electronics for recycling in Gaylords (on pallets) or shrink wrap onto pallets. Members simply contact the NRRA when the minimum "pick-up" requirements are met.

### **One Day Collection Electronics Recycling Program**



Members not able to collect electronics on a permanent basis can offer their residents a one-day recycling event. Once a date has been selected, NRRA will assist the member to set-up and promote the collection event to residents.

## Containerized Electronics Recycling Program



Members collect and store electronics for recycling in a closed container provided by the NRRA vendor. When the container is full, simply contact NRRA to arrange for pick-up.

## On-Site Trailer Electronics Recycling Program



NRRA members collect and store electronics in the on-site trailers provided by NRRA's vendor. Electronics will be stored in gaylords on pallets also provided by the vendor. When the trailer is full, simply contact NRRA to arrange for a trailer swap.

## Suggested Fees to Charge Residents Electronics Recycling

Large Console TV - \$20  
Mid to Small TV, Computer Monitor, Printer - \$10  
Computer (CPU) - \$5
