Recharging the Planet. Recycling Your Batteries.

Rechargeable batteries typically found in . . .

- . . . cordless power tools . . .
- . . . cell and cordless phones . . .
- . . . laptop computers . . .
- . . . camcorders . . .
- . . . digital cameras . . .
- . . . remote control toys . . .

. . . can be recharged up to 1,000 times before eventually wearing out. These commonly used batteries contain heavy metals, including Nickel Cadmium (Ni-Cd), Nickel Metal Hydride (Ni-MH), Lithium Ion (Li-ion) and Small Sealed Lead (Pb), that, if disposed of improperly, can pollute ground water and cause air pollution. Alkaline batteries can be safely disposed with the household waste and button cell batteries should be sent with household hazardous waste.



FREE Program **Available!!!**

The Call2Recycle (formerly RBRC) program keeps rechargeable batteries out of the solid waste stream! Participating communities receive FREE collection boxes and pre-paid shipping labels. Simply fill the box with the collected rechargeable batteries, tape it up and send it off for recycling! The members of the Northeast Resource Recovery Association (NRRA) can now sign up for this FREE program! **Rechargeable Batteries up to two pounds can be shipped and individual bags are provided with each collection box.** See order for on reverse side.

What happens to the batteries recycled through the Call2Recycle Program?

Collected batteries are shipped to a recycling facility for processing. The reclaimed materials can be used to make new products, such as new batteries and stainless steel products.
