Vilas School collects newspapers and stores them until a measureable quantity have been accumulated. The papers are then brought to a local farm to be shredded. Once they are compacted, the shredded paper is delivered to farms in the community. Farm owners then use the shredded newspaper to line the stalls of their barns. In the winter this helps to keep animals warm and is environmentally friendly to the ecosystem of the farmyard and surrounding property. Many tons of recycled newspaper has been utilized for this purpose during the 2013-2014 academic year. This program keeps the community and the school connection strong.
