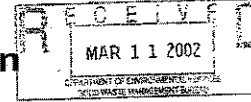

ATTACHMENT A TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. The facility shall be closed in conformance with the requirements of the New Hampshire Solid Waste Rules (Rules) and in accordance with plans to be approved by the Department of Environmental Services, Waste Management Division.
2. The closed facility shall be maintained in conformance with Env-Wm 2507.04 of the Rules and in accordance with approved closure plans.
3. Facility closure shall comply with Parts Env-Wm 308 and 312 of the Rules.
4. In accordance with Solid Waste Rule Env-Wm 2507.05(f), record drawings shall be submitted to the Department upon completion of closure construction.
5. In accordance with Solid Waste Rule Env-Wm 2507.05(g), notification that a landfill exists on the property shall be attached to the property deed. The notification, as a minimum, shall include the following information:
 - (a) A statement that a landfill exists on this property.
 - (b) Identification of the Registry of Deeds, book and page numbers where title to the property is recorded.
 - (c) Identification of the property tax map and lot numbers as identified by the political subdivision in which the facility is located.
 - (d) Identification of the USGS coordinates listing the site of the landfill.
 - (e) Description of the type and size of the facility.
 - (f) Description of closure implemented and identification of the Permit issued by the Department of Environmental Services under which closure occurred, including a statement that the Permit may contain certain legal obligations regarding this site.
 - (g) A statement that post-closure use of the property shall not disturb the integrity of the final cover, liners, or any other components of the containment systems or the function of the monitoring systems unless necessary to comply with the requirements of the New Hampshire Solid Waste Rules.
 - (h) A statement that any future change in use must be proposed to the Division for review and approval/denial determination.
 - (i) A statement that access shall be assured to Department inspection personnel and the permit holder for monitoring/maintenance purposes.



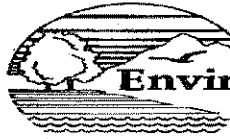

TERMS & CONDITIONS (CONT.)

- (9) **Facility Capacity:** The facility's approved capacity, as defined by Env-Wm 102.08(a), shall be that quantity of authorized wastes which can be handled by the facility within the terms of this permit, in a safe and environmentally protective manner and which is not in excess of 4,000 tons per month.
- (10) **Storage Limits:** This facility's approved storage capacity, as defined by Env-Wm 102.11, shall be as follows:
- (a) Metals (all types) - 1,200 tons;
 - (b) Bypass and residual wastes (all waste other than scrap metal) - 4 cubic yards.
- All authorized wastes shall be transferred to a marketplace or to a permitted waste management facility in accordance with Env-Wm 2105.03(a) of the Rules.
- (11) **Operating Requirements:** This facility shall operate in compliance with the following requirements, as in effect on the issue date of this permit and as may be amended subsequent to the issue date of this permit:
- (a) RSA 149-M;
 - (b) the New Hampshire Solid Waste Rules (ref. Env-Wm 100-300 & 2100-2800), specifically including Env-Wm 308, 311 and 2105;
 - (c) all terms and conditions of this permit;
 - (d) the Operating Plan which was submitted to the Department as part of the Permit Application, except as may be amended by the terms and conditions of this permit; and
 - (e) the provisions of any other present or future requisite federal, state or local permits, licenses or approvals which may be required for the operation of this facility.
- (12) **Closure Requirements:** Closure of this facility shall comply with the following requirements, as in effect on the issue date of this permit and as may be amended subsequent to the issue date of this permit:
- (a) RSA 149-M;
 - (b) the New Hampshire Solid Waste Rules (ref. Env-Wm 100-300 & 2100-2800), specifically including Env-Wm 308, 312 and 2106;
 - (c) all terms and conditions of this permit;
 - (d) the provisions of the facility's Closure Plan which was submitted to the Department as part of the Permit Application; and
 - (e) the provisions of any other present or future requisite federal, state or local permits, licenses or approvals which apply to closure of this facility.
- (13) **Financial Assurance:** The permittee shall assure the cost of facility closure in accordance with Env-Wm 313. The permittee shall assure the availability of such funds throughout the operating life of the facility. Each year in the facility's annual report, the permittee shall identify and show proof that the required financial assurance provisions are and shall remain in effect in accordance with Env-Wm 313. Within 30 days of learning that any portion of its financial assurance is or will be canceled or otherwise unavailable, the permittee shall submit a proposal to replace the lost financial assurance in accordance with Env-Wm 313.



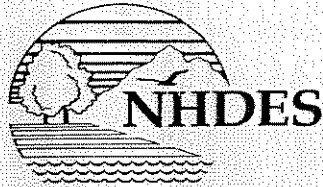
