Lucinda “Cinny” Griswold (Candia, NH) Recognized as Recycling Volunteer of the Year

EPSOM, NH (June 1, 2016) The Northeast Resource Recovery Association (NRRRA) honored Lucinda “Cinny” Griswold as Volunteer of the Year on Monday, May 16 2016 at NRRRA’s Annual Conference and Expo, held at The Radisson Hotel in Nashua, NH.

The Volunteer of the Year award is given to an individual who has gone above and beyond to help a town organization improve its recycling efforts.

Lucinda Griswold is a volunteer at the Candia, New Hampshire Recycling Center. She volunteers 6-12 hours per week and is the lead volunteer at the “swap shop,” which is a facility at the Candia Recycling Center that allows residents to bring items no longer wanted so other residents can take and reuse.

“Cinny is a dedicated volunteer to the Candia Recycling Center,” said Chuck Witcher, Manager, Candia, NH Recycling Center. “She supports what we are trying to do, which is recycle, reduce and reuse. The swap shop is an integral part of recycling, keeping usable items out of the landfill.”

Additionally, Cinny coordinated fundraising for swap shop improvements at no cost to the taxpayers. She dedicated a \$4,000 sweeper attachment for our loader in the memory of her Dad, Jim Griswold, a well-known philanthropist.
